PARISH TRIP TO POLAND – 27TH TO 31ST MAY 2019

I am arranging a parish trip to Poland in May next year with the kind assistance of our parish Polish Sisters. The trip will include Krakow, the Market Square, Wawel Castle, Barbikan, St Florian's Gate, St Mary's Basilica and the Sanctuary of Our Lord's Mercy. There will also be a trip to Wadowice, the birthplace of Pope John Paul II, and also a visit to Czestochowa, Jasna Gora – the famous shrine to the Black Madonna and another excursion will include a walk through the Jewish District. Cost is approx. £630 per person, sharing (if single room there will be a £146 supplement). All in all, it should be a fascinating visit.
