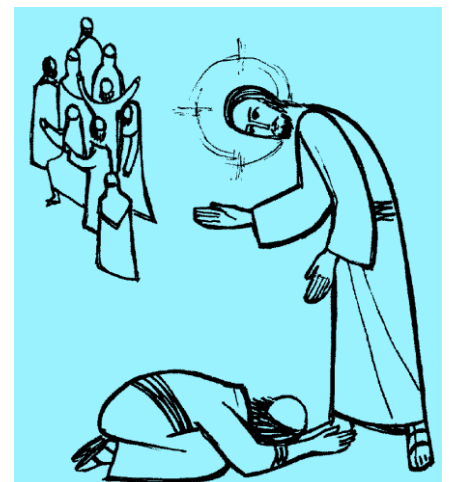

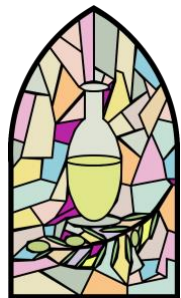

CANONISATION OF BLESSED JOHN HENRY NEWMAN

Blessed John Henry Newman is to be canonised today (Sunday) in St Peter's Square in Rome. He will be the first English person since the 17th Century to be officially recognised as a saint by the Catholic Church.

The hymns at the 10.30am Mass today will all be hymns written by Cardinal Newman. There will be a special cake served with the refreshments in the hall after Mass.

“I will be attending the canonisation and will offer the weekly Mass for parishioners in Rome. I will be back on Monday. My thanks to Fr Darren Carden for again supplying.” *Canon C*

Extract from a meditation of Cardinal John Henry Newman (1801-1890)

“I am created to do something or to be something for which no one else is created: I have a place in God's counsels, in God's world, which no one else has; whether I be rich or poor, despised or esteemed by man, God knows me and calls me by my name.

God has created me to do Him some definite service; He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission – I never may know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next.”

Prayer of self-offering

“I give myself to you. I trust you wholly. You are wiser than I – more loving to me than I myself. Fulfil your high purposes in me whatever they be – work in and through me. I am born to serve you, to be yours, to be your instrument. Let me be your blind instrument. I ask not to see – I ask not to know – I ask simply to be used.”
